Programme Overview

The Master of Science in Mental Health Psychology (MSMHP) is a globally benchmarked postgraduate degree designed for individuals committed to improving psychological well-being through research-informed and practice-oriented approaches. It equips professionals with advanced knowledge of mental health, psychological theory, counseling techniques, and applied intervention strategies relevant across clinical, educational, and organizational contexts.

- Total Credits: 90 ECTS
- Modules: 13 (12 core modules + 1 Capstone Project)
- Duration: 12–18 months (depending on study route)

This flexible online programme is ideal for both aspiring mental health professionals and experienced practitioners seeking structured academic validation of their expertise.

Programme Structure & Learning Model

The MSMHP programme follows a reflective, open-learning approach combining curated Open Educational Resources (OERs) with in-depth assignments. For each module, students are required to:

1. Access the provided open-source course link
2. Sign up and complete the course

3. Download the free Statement of Participation upon course completion
4. Write a Reflection Paper (minimum 4,000 words) addressing:
 - a) Key Concepts Learned from the Course – 1,000 words
 - b) Application in Real-Life/Workplace Context – 1,500 words
 - c) Challenges in Implementation – 1,500 words
5. Upload both the Statement of Participation and Reflection Paper via the LMS
6. Repeat the above for all 12 modules
7. Complete a final 5,000-word Capstone Project

Assessment

Each module is evaluated through a 5,000-word written assignment demonstrating theory application, critical analysis, and evidence-based reasoning in line with EIU–Paris academic quality standards.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Hold a recognized Bachelor's degree in any field, or
- Possess a recognized Postgraduate Diploma (Level 7 equivalent) in Psychology, Counseling, Social Work, or Mental Health, and
- At least 1 year of professional experience in mental health, social work, counseling, or related roles

Mature Entry Route (case-by-case):

- A minimum of 9 years of documented experience in psychology or related fields, with proof of formal client work, therapy services, or psychosocial interventions

English Language Proficiency

- No test required if prior education was in English
- Others may submit IELTS/TOEFL scores or take the EIU–Paris in-house test

Technical Requirements

- Basic computer and internet literacy
- Access to reliable internet and a personal device

Tuition Fee Structure
